



AC Centennial Cup Rules

The Centennial Cup is an annual doubles play-off competition between all Croquet Auckland Clubs.

The flyer advertising the event contains the date and venue for the final along with entry information.

Eligibility:

1. The winners of each club's opening doubles tournament of the season are eligible to represent their club in the Centennial Cup Finals event.
2. The opening club event should be based on an individual entry with a seeded draw worked out as follows
 - a. Players are listed in handicap order. Where more than one player has the same handicap, randomly prioritise.
 - b. The lowest handicap player is selected to partner the highest handicap player; the second lowest to partner the second highest; and so on.
3. Club games are limited to 3 hours handicap play with Regulation 9
4. Should a club have insufficient players to hold a club event, such club should contact the Tournament Manager to seek dispensation to these rules for their entry to the final event.
