The Helensville Bowling Club first started under the name of Awaroa Bowling Club in the season of 1913/14 The ladies club was established after the demise of the croquet club on the adjoining property in the 1952/53 season. Like many clubs through out the country both mens and ladies clubs amalgamated in the 1998/99 season. In 1985 the mens club shifted from the Auckland Centre to the North Shore Centre, now known as North Harbour. Glancing around the walls of the main lounge area it is obvious the club has always had it's share of talent. One can count 20 Auckland and 39 North Harbour centre titles. Adding to this impressive display there are three National titles. Helensville has also won the North Harbour Mens A Division Interclub competition five times in the last seven years.

ABOUT HELENSVILLE TENNIS CLUB

The Helensville Tennis Club was started in 1913 and celebrated its centenary in 2014. Its home was adjacent to the Croquet Club in Awaroa Road until 1994 when the club contributed to the establishment of Rautawhiri Park Trust.

There was a short period the club went into recess however it was revitalised in 2006-2007, reincorporated in 2013 and has continued to grow stronger since.

In 2015 the club was successful in securing the Community Lease from Auckland Council for the Rautawhiri Park Pavilion and the four astro turf courts. Securing the lease for the Rautawhiri Park Pavilion and the astro turf courts will allow the club to continue to support the existing user groups, actively promote the availability of the pavilion to the wider community while protecting and improving the assets.
